FAMILY ADVENTURE LOOK AT A PICTURE BIBLE

A colorful, realistic picture Bible is a wonderful tool to introduce your child to the “heroes” of faith named in Hebrews 11 and many other people who loved God and obeyed Him. Hold your baby in your lap and slowly thumb through a Bible to find pictures and names. Thank God for the stories of faithful people who showed their love for God.

FAMILY ADVENTURE “WRITE” BIBLE WORDS

Use dashed letters to write the words *Hebrews* and *God* on separate sheets of paper. Show the papers to your toddler and read the words. Say: “These words are in the Bible. Let’s look for the words.”

Open your child’s Bible to the Book of Hebrews and use a yellow crayon to highlight the words.

Give your toddler one paper at a time. Guide her to trace over the letters with a crayon, then decorate the page.
