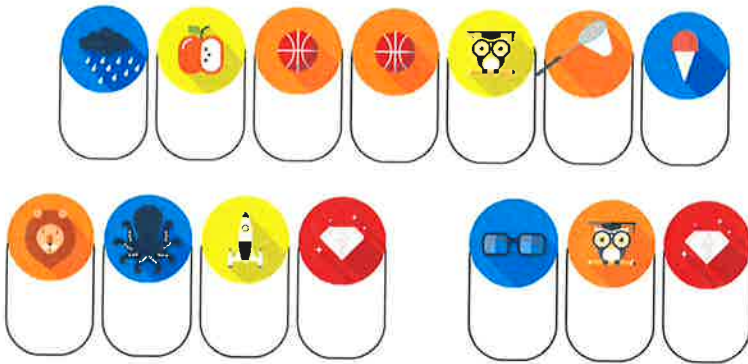


JESUS APPEARED TO MARY AND THOMAS

This relief from the Middle Ages shows Mary Magdalene holding a jar of spices. Mary's face looks tired and sad. Mary went to Jesus' tomb after the Sabbath to anoint His body with spices. Show a friend how you think Mary's face looked when she discovered the empty tomb!



A relief is a sculpture that is still attached to the surface it was carved from.

PYX

A **PYX** is a small container that is sometimes used to hold the bread for the Lord's Supper. During the Lord's Supper, people who have turned from their sins and trusted Jesus eat bread and drink juice to **REMEMBER** how Jesus' death paid for their sins.

This pyx is over **1,500 YEARS OLD**. Look closely. Do you see the women carved into the pyx? This carving represents Mary and the other Mary at Jesus' tomb. Check out **JOHN 20** to discover what happened when the women learned the tomb was empty.
