## *Family Devotion*

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

### Summary: Romans 10:5-15


The more important or substantial the goal, the more achieving it will require of us. One of the things Paul wanted most was to see his fellow Jews trust in Christ (Rom. 10:1). He was willing to go to great lengths to see this happen (Rom. 9:3). In fact, one of his goals in writing to the church at Rome was to improve relationships between Jewish and Gentile Christians so both might better point people to Christ. For Paul's fellow Jews to come to Christ, they first needed to admit that the way they were relying on the Law wasn't working. Secondly, they needed to see that Jesus is Lord of all and offers salvation to all who call on Him by faith.

**.02 CAN PEOPLE BE SAVED WITHOUT HEARING THE GOSPEL? EXPLAIN.**
