Summary: Romans 13:1-14

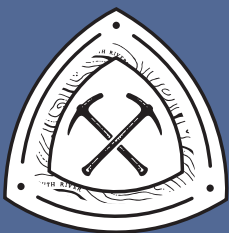

And yet, when Paul wrote to the church at Rome, he reminded them to do these very things. We need to remember that following Jesus means doing everything we can to live honorably in the world as representatives of the King.
