## ROMANS 6:1-14

### CENTRAL TRUTH

Jesus conquered sin and death so that we might truly live.

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#### Romans 6:1-7

Read verses 1-7, then consider the following questions individually or as a group.

**.03 WHAT WAS PAUL COMMUNICATING BY HIS QUESTION IN VERSE 1?**

**.04 WHAT DOES PAUL'S ANSWER TO HIS OWN QUESTION TELL US ABOUT WHAT IT MEANS TO FOLLOW JESUS?**

**.05 DO YOU PRESENTLY THINK OF YOURSELF AS DEAD TO SIN AND RAISED TO LIFE? WHY OR WHY NOT?**

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#### Romans 6:8-11

Read verses 8-11, then consider the following questions individually or as a group.

**.06 WHAT DID JESUS ACCOMPLISH FOR US THROUGH HIS DEATH AND RESURRECTION?**

**.07 WHAT DOES THE FACT THAT DEATH NO LONGER RULES OVER JESUS TELL US ABOUT HIM? WHY IS THIS GOOD NEWS?**

**.08 IN LIGHT OF JESUS' DEATH AND RESURRECTION, HOW SHOULD WE SEE OURSELVES (V. 11)? DOES THIS COME NATURALLY TO YOU? EXPLAIN.**

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#### Romans 6:12-14

Read verses 12-14, then consider the following questions individually or as a group.

**.09 HOW DOES SIN CONTROL THE LIVES OF MANY TEENS TODAY? WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE TO NOT LET SIN REIGN OVER YOU?**

**.10 HOW DOES BEING UNDER GRACE RATHER THAN THE LAW EMPOWER US TO OBEY GOD? EXPLAIN.**

We need to apply the truth of God's Word to our lives. Think through these questions and how you can live out what you've studied in Romans 6:1-14 this week.

**.11 HAS TODAY'S SESSION CHALLENGED OR CHANGED HOW YOU THINK OF WHAT IT MEANS TO BE FREE? EXPLAIN.**

**.12 DO YOU ACTIVELY THINK OF YOURSELF AS DEAD TO SIN AND ALIVE IN CHRIST? WHAT MIGHT KEEP US FROM SEEING OURSELVES THIS WAY?**

**.13 HOW MIGHT WE HELP OR ENCOURAGE EACH OTHER TO MORE CONSISTENTLY LIVE OUT OUR NEW IDENTITY IN CHRIST?**

**.14 AS ONE WHO HAS BEEN RAISED TO NEW LIFE IN CHRIST, HOW WILL YOU LIVE DIFFERENTLY THIS WEEK AT SCHOOL? ON SOCIAL MEDIA? AT HOME?**
