As You Go

Family Devotion

Consider following up with your student later in the week with the following summary and discussion questions.

Summary: Proverbs 3:1-12

We live in a culture that is constantly telling us to look inside ourselves when it comes to making decisions—to trust our gut, our instincts, or our desires. Today, however, we will see that Proverbs tells us to do the opposite—to look outside ourselves and toward God. Rather than trusting ourselves, we should remember the teaching of God's Word, and rather than relying on our instincts or desires, Proverbs tells us to trust in the Lord with all our heart. This is the path to life. God blesses and directs those who place their trust in Him.

.02 HOW HAS THE GUIDANCE OF SOMEONE OLDER IN THE FAITH HELPED YOU GROW?
