Summary: Proverbs 8:6-21

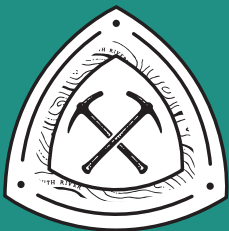
When it comes to making decisions, whether large or small, getting good advice can make all the difference. On the other hand, bad advice can be devastating—it can cause us to make decisions we regret or to even hurt people we care about. In today's passage, Solomon writes from the perspective of Wisdom itself and as he does so, he makes clear that the best advice, advice that changes us for the better, is found in the Lord and in His Word.
