Summary: Proverbs 5:3-11,15-18

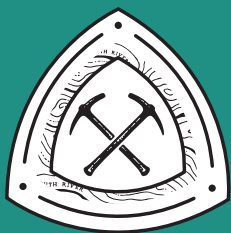

The more we familiarize ourselves with God's design and look to Him for the strength to submit to His design, the better prepared we will be when faced with temptation. Discussion Questions

.01 ACCORDING TO SOLOMON, HOW SHOULD WE RESPOND WHEN WE ARE FACED WITH SEXUAL TEMPTATION?

.02 WHAT BENEFITS COME FROM SUBMITTING TO GOD'S DESIGN FOR OUR LIVES AND OUR BODIES?
