Summary: Song of Songs 2:15-3:5

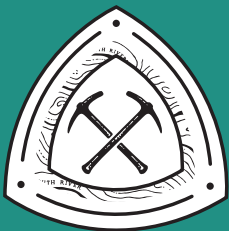
Whether you are an introvert or an extrovert, there are certain things that are better when we have people to share them with. This reminds us of an important truth with regard to God's design for us: He designed us for relationships. We have discussed the value of marriage and how God calls us to honor and protect it, but this session also reminded us of the value of all our relationships, particularly our most important relationship. God created us for relationships, with the greatest relationship being between Him and His people.

.02 WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM THE EXAMPLE OF GODLY, FAITHFUL MARRIAGES?
