ISAIAH 6:1-13

HOLY PURPOSE

CENTRAL truth 

Our God is holy, and we must look to Him to forgive our sins and direct our lives.

“What do you live for?” If you asked various people your age in your neighborhood or school this question, what kinds of answers do you think you would get?

How might your answer to this question shape the way you live? In the next year? In the next ten years?

ISAIAH 6:1-7

Read Isaiah 6:1-7, then answer the following questions.

- .01** Why might Isaiah have mentioned that this vision took place in the year that King Uzziah died?
- .02** What are seraphim? What do the actions and words of the seraphim communicate about God?
- .03** How did Isaiah respond to this vision of God and the words of the seraphim? How do you think you would respond to such a vision?

ISAIAH 6:8-10

Read verses 8-10, then answer the following questions and review with your group.

- .04** What did God do for Isaiah (vv. 6-7) and how does that relate to what God asked of him in verse 8? Why are both of these details good news?
- .05** How did Isaiah respond to God’s call in verse 8? Given what Isaiah witnessed in this vision, does this surprise you? Explain.
- .06** Look back at verses 6-7. How does knowing we are forgiven help us to obey God and live for Him?

ISAIAH 6:11-13

Read verses 11-13, then answer the following questions. Ask a few students to share their responses with the group.

- .07** Look back at Isaiah 6:9-10. What message was Isaiah to proclaim to the people of Judah and Jerusalem? How did Isaiah respond (v. 11)?
- .08** What was God’s purpose in calling Isaiah to proclaim this message? What was God doing despite the hard hearts of His people?
